Our second vintage of Syrah from this "Cru" vineyard in the south corner of the Ballard Canyon AVA, Kimsey Vineyard. This vintage does differ from 2017 in that it was completely destemmed, we used no new oak and we did not co-ferment with Viognier. We did still blend the final wine with just 2% of Viognier to add a floral note to the nose. This is a classic expression of a cooler climate Syrah. It

starts with a purposeful note of flinty reduction that we strive for in our winemaking. Then leads into purple and white flowers, vanilla candle and sweet tobacco along with classic Syrah notes of under ripe tiny blueberries, bloody meat and spice. Silky, ripe tannins with bright acidity lead to a long beautiful finish.”
