Bright, fresh and lively....those are the attributes we desire in our Chardonnays. We often use the term "racy" when trying to describe them. This wine hits all those marks. The best part is that it is a perfect representation of the terroir it was grown and made in. The west end of the SRH is known for minerally driven Chards and this is no exception. The vibrant acidity leads to specific aromas of granite and wet stone often associated with the term "mineral". Woven in that is a beautiful bouquet of white flowers with a hint of lime. The palate is rock solid, no pun intended, and leads one straight to sandy soils it came from. Laser focused without a touch of abrasiveness. Causing one to stand up and take notice. This wine forces you to contemplate the potential of Chardonnay in this region.
