Whole cluster pressed and fermented and aged in a once used and twice used French oak barrel. One of our best efforts to date. Wonderful balance of acidity and freshness on this wine. The aromas start with a slightly flinty note of reduction which may take the consumer's mind to Condrieu. The honeysuckle, grapefruit and ripe melons on the palette would also lead you to believe you're drinking France. However, the acidity of Santa Barbara County brings you back to California and is what keeps this wine balanced and bright. "
